Housing and homelessness is a visible and divisive issue in local media, in politics, and across communities within our state.

According to the state's housing finance agency, Oregon has 140,000 fewer homes than it needs for our current population, with approximately 18,000 people currently experiencing homelessness.

This conversation led by Paul Susi will explore common assumptions and perspectives about the experience of homelessness and seeks to answer the question:

How do we decide who “belongs” in our community?
